In 1812 the family moved to Berlin, Germany, where Abraham established himself as a banker, converted to Protestantism (a branch of Christian religion), and changed the family name to Mendelssohn-Bartholdy. Felix and his elder sister, Fanny, received their early piano instruction from their mother.
